Lack of state, weak bourgeoisie, perypheral location, closed elites, protestanism

Poland in the end of 18th century

Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth lost its state

 Society divided into three estates: noblemen, peasantry and bourgoisie (ethnic division)

Noblemen divided into aristocracy and gentry

Migration and social change

Arnold von Gennyp, Victor Turner, Edith Turner Rite of passage: separation, transition, reincorporation

Emigration: preliminal, liminal phase: antistructure, between and betweex, communitas, emotional energy

Immigration: the other, unknown, anxiety, insecurity, Add Swinder – culture as 'tool-kit'


Culture as 'tool-kit"


