National and Regional Developments


- ◆ Regional Autonomy in Europe
- ◆ Development of linguistic legislation
- ◆ Development of Language Boards across Europe
- ◆ Development and establishment of language planning as a professional science and area of expertise (professionalisation of language planning)
- ◆ Network of Language Planning Boards – sharing of best practice



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Issues facing language planners in Europe

- ◆ Similar issues – different points on the axis
 - ◆ Need to share good practise and experience
 - ◆ Expansion of EU – Linguistic situation more complex
 - ◆ Inherent need to support and sustain linguistic diversity.
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Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity

- ◆ Funded by the European Commission (450k€ over 3 years)
- ◆ Europe wide network to promote linguistic diversity.....



Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity – aims of the Network

- ◆ Undertaking project work
- ◆ Up to date information on regional and minority languages
- ◆ Lobbying force in Brussels
- ◆ Exchanging best practice
- ◆ Partnership forming
- ◆ Capacity building

Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity – Advantages Networking

- The ability to embrace a broad variety of stakeholders;
- The possibility of integrating existing structures;
- Its flexibility in adapting to changing needs in the dynamic context of languages;

Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity - membership

- ◆ schools;
- ◆ voluntary organisations;
- ◆ private foundations;
- ◆ youth organisations;
- ◆ cultural organisations;
- ◆ other groups accepted by the General Assembly.



Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity - structures

- ◆ Two tiers of membership
- ◆ Members
 - National and regional governments, language planning boards
- ◆ Associate Members
 - All other organisations

Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity - structures

- ◆ Budgetary arrangements
 - Grant funding by European Commission (450k € over 3 years)
 - Core funding – membership fees
 - Other EU funding for project work

Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity - timetable

- ◆ Official launch in January 2008 by Commissioner Orban

Network to Promote Linguistic Diversity – priorities

- ◆ Intergenerational language transmission and pre school learning
- ◆ Motivation to learn and increasing usage
- ◆ Healthcare

- ◆ Promoting languages to young people

- ◆ Project sharing best practice on the implementation of language legislation for civil servants
